### Food For Thought--

Dickey's BBQ Pit Coming to The Gardens on Havana!



**B**BQ connoisseurs alert! Dickey's BBQ Pit, a staple for many years in North Texas, is coming to Main Street at The Gardens on Havana. Started by Travis Dickey just north of downtown Dallas in 1941, Dickey's BBQ Pit has been serving up Texas Style BBQ for over 70 years.

There are four major regional classifications of BBQ in the U.S.A.: Texas, Kansas City, Memphis, and Carolina. There are several subdivisions of each classification, with Texas BBQ alone having East, Central, South and West distinctions. In general though, perfect Texas style BBQ is slow-cooked, falling-off- thebone tender, hickory smoked meat. BBQ Beef Brisket has been

described as the, "national dish of the Republic of Texas." BBQ rubs can be as simple as "Dalmatian rub," consisting of plain old salt and pepper, or rubs can be a secret concoction of spices. The Texas BBQ Beef Brisket sauce is a blend of tomato sauce thinned with vinegar and Worchester and a secret combination of spices.

On the menu at Dickey's BBQ Pit, you will find beef brisket, pulled pork, ham, Polish sausage, turkey breast, and chicken. These perfect BBQ meats are served with homestyle sides including jalapeno beans and mac & cheese. Each meal comes with buttery rolls, complimentary ice cream and a dill pickle. ### **COMMERCIAL PROPERTY WATERING RESTRICTIONS:**



Commercial property owners asked us to clarify the watering restrictions the City of Aurora has adopted for the Stage 1 drought this summer as those restrictions apply to commercial properties in the city. Commercial property owners invest thousands of dollars each year

in pots and annuals to make their properties appealing.

No commercial property owner in their right mind would spend money on annuals and flowers in pots if they could not water them enough to keep them alive. After calling Aurora Water, we found out that commercial properties in the city are on two day a week watering schedule (just as residential properties). The Commercial Property watering days are Tuesdays and Fridays, but that restriction applies to turf and large areas that are watered with automatic sprinklers. Flowers planted in flower pots or annual beds can be watered by drip irrigation or handwatering at any time. The Tuesday/Friday commercial watering restriction does not apply to flowers in pots or annual beds. So, commercial property owners, go out and plant those annuals in pots and make Havana Street beautiful!

#### 2013 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES MAILED OUT MAY 1:

Did you receive your property tax notice? The Arapahoe County Assessor's office mailed out property tax notices on May 1, 2013. By law, the assessor's office has to use market values based on the "appraisal date" of **June 30, 2012.** In determining the value of your property, the assessor will be using sales taking place from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012 for the property tax notices that will be mailed out on May 1, 2013. Current market values will not be reflected until the 2015 tax notices.

Residential values are based on sales comps only.

Commercial property values are based on three approaches:

- Market approach: The actual value of the subject property based on the arm's length sales of similar properties.
- Cost approach: The actual value of subject property based on an estimate of the cost to replace the property with a substitute that is equivalent in function and utility.
- **Income approach**: The annual net income of the subject property is capitalized to account for a typical investor's financial return on the investment.

### **FANFARE REMEDIATION UPDATE: Excavators Have Arrived!**





Love It! Two excavators arrived at the Fanfare site this week! LVI Environmental Services continues to work on the interior remediation of environmental hazards (asbestos and pidgeon droppings) from the old Fanfare building. The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the EPA have approved the exterior remediation and demolition plans, according the the Fanfare owner's spokesperson. The spokesperson said he did not have an exact date yet, but that he has promised the local news media that they will be contacted once the date is set and crews begin taking large chunks of the old Fanfare building down. We have been told to expect the building to be down and the site "clean" by fall of 2013. Watch this newsletter and the website for notification of the date and time for our big demolition celebration that is being planned by Council Member Marsha Berzins in conjunction with On Havana Street and the Aurora Chamber of Commerce.

### FAMILY DOLLAR STORE UNDER CONSTRUCTION:



The old Spotlite Video building at 465 N. Havana has been demolished and construction has begun on the new, brick Family Dollar Store. The foundation has been poured and the steel structure is taking shape.

#### TOYS & BABIES R US UNDER CONSTRUCTION:



What is that big building going up at Mississippi & Ironton at The Gardens on Havana? It is Toys & Babies R Us! The walls are up on this 46,737 sf anchor. The ledgestone is being installed on the building. Watch for a soft opening in late September with a big grand opening in October 2013!

### APARTMENTS AND TOWNHOMES AT THE GARDENS ON HAVANA:

The financing has been approved for 217 new apartments and 10 new townhomes to be built adjacent to The Gardens on Havana! Construction on the apartments, along S. Joliet Street to the east of The Gardens on Havana, should start in May, weather permitting. The developer is Post Investment Group of Los Angeles, CA. We are looking forward to this residential piece of the beautiful Gardens on Havana Retail Development.

### **Automotive:** Uber Cash For Clunkers--Clear The Air Foundation

Win-Win-Win! The program is called Clear the Air Foundation and it is sponsored by the Colorado Automobile Dealers Association (CADA). This program could be described as the "uber" version of Cash For Clunkers. Key components of this program:

- It gets the worse of the bad polluters off the street and clears the air
- It addresses the major concern that Classic Car Enthusiasts had about the
  original Cash for Clunkers program-this program preserves the supply of older car
  parts. The vehicles are processed for resalable and recyclable parts before the
  cars are crushed. Car enthusiasts complained that the original Cash For
  Clunkers was also destroying all of the replacement parts that they needed for
  their car collector hobby.
- The proceeds from the parts sales and the sale of the crushed metal go directly back into the program to provide scholarships for students enrolling in auto industry job training programs. The average salvage yard pays the foundation \$300/vehicle.
- The dealerships get a tax deduction for donating cars to this program.

According to CADA, to date the foundation has collected \$168,000 and the dealership association has agreed to contribute \$1 million. What a great program to perpetuate the love of cars by preserving the parts for our classic car collector enthusiasts and, at the same time, providing scholarships for job training, instilling the love of cars in our millennial generation!
