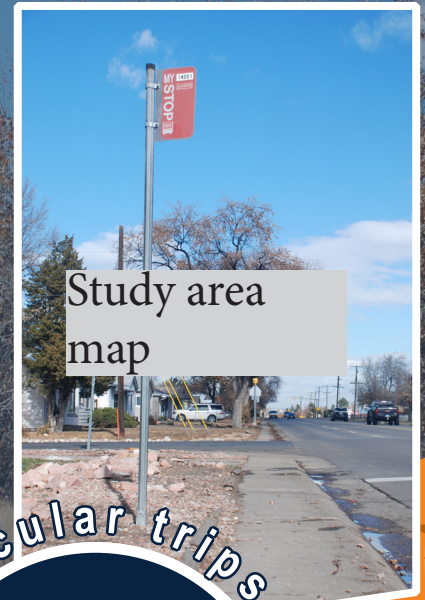
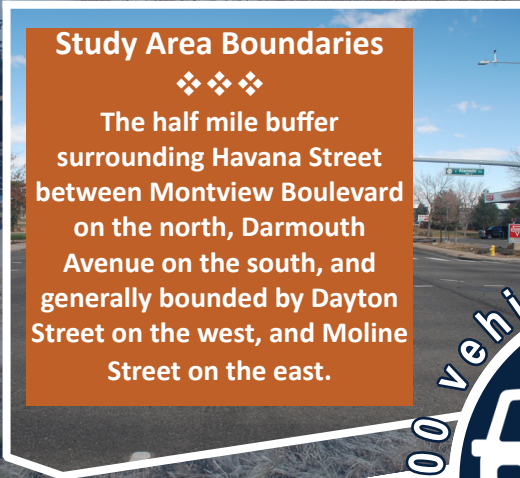


# HAVANA STREET CORRIDOR STUDY
