

October 2021 – What’s Happening On Havana Street & BID Updates:

BID Budget & Operations:

- Received \$2,731.30 from Arapahoe County on 10/7 and on 10/8 we had about \$557,364 in the First Bank and \$201,948 in the Bank of the West accounts.
- **The BID’s Operational Plan and Budget for 2022: Review the Proposed Plan [here](#).** The PRELIM AV’s were received in late August by Arapahoe County, the BID presented the preliminary budgets for 2022 to the board at the 9/17 BID Board Meeting, then submits the plan to the City of Aurora’s M&F, Study Session (10/18) and City Council (11/22). Then in late November 2021 the BID should receive the final AV’s and the BID can resubmit the updated budget with changes to the BID board and the City of Aurora. The FINAL budget will be certified with the mill levy on 12/9 with Spencer Fane, the special district attorney. **Then the final budget is due to the county and state on 12/15.**

Live On Havana Street Update:

- **A new application for duplexes was received by a Rachid in the Planning at 2225 S Iola St. behind Addis Ababa Ethiopian Restaurant.**
- **Mountain View United Church & Habitat for Humanity** have “formed a collaborative partnership with the Congregation Land Campaign and Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver. They are creating a site plan using its vacant property next to the church to provide inclusive, owner-occupied, affordable housing for working families in the 60-80% Area Median Income range.” – from a blog post in [MVUC’s website](#). On 6/15/2021 the housing project shared that their zoning application has been submitted and accepted by the city. Learn More about the 10-duplex cul-de-sac style development [here](#).
- **Mubarak Villa:** This is a 20-unit duplex development in ten buildings on 1.75 acres proposed on the north side of Jewell Avenue, about a quarter mile west of Havana Street. **“Mubarak Villa is finalizing fees with the School District and the civil plan process almost complete.”**

- **Argenta:** Phase 1- 3.6 acres for 86 townhomes construction is in progress. Argenta is a phased master plan for 10.55 acres new mixed-use development consisting of 86 townhomes, 208 multi-family & 20,000 SF of small-scale retail.
 - **Townhomes (Phase 1): Summary timeframe:** The contractor must complete, water, related road work on Geneva, and other work for the city. There has been no construction on buildings to date and is not likely until Spring 2022.
 - **Multi-Family Units (Phase II): Summary timeframe:** Before MF units can start construction, the N-S Road would have to be completed. To complete road, they would likely stop in October due to freeze-thaw and would not complete the N-S Road until spring. Sometime after that Phase II could begin.
- **Wet Utilities:** The contractors must complete wet utilities before they can start the N-S road through the center of the development. This road must be installed for Phase 2 (MF / Retail) to start construction. Timeframe: wet utilities - 2-3 weeks.
- **N-S Road Phase 2 (for Multi-Family): Summary timeframe:** before N-S Road can start, it would take at minimum 2 months to complete construction including wet utilities timing above. To complete road, they would likely stop in October due to freeze-thaw and could not complete the N-S Road until spring. District Identity: Sam’s No 3 and The Better Mattress district marker panels are being ordered and expect to be installed before the winter season. **Kum & Go at Havana & Jewel expressed interest in adding an On Havana Street sign to their monument if BID can provide the panels then KG will cover the install. Also, Kum & Go offered to add an 8x8 concrete pad for the ART 2C public art program if the District supports the additional sculpture to the Art 2C program. This pad would not be available until 2023 so it would be included in the 2024-2026 program.**

Sales Tax Reports from the City of Aurora: Overall, the District is doing better than most shopping districts and special districts, despite the pandemic. However, it is difficult to predict the sales tax for the end of 2021 and early into 2022 since we expect more business closures, empty leases, and many new leases in the next two to six months. **However, the District is also trending to exceed pre-pandemic numbers/2019’s Sales Tax revenue based on the most recent report from the City of Aurora.**

Similar to other shopping districts in the City of Aurora with sales tax collections, things are looking good in the District.

- Year-to-date sales tax collections from businesses in the corridor through the end of September were \$17.6M.
- This amount is \$2.3M (15.1%) more than was collected in 2020.
- Since 2020 was a strange and unique year, with the COVID-19 pandemic causing significant economic disruption, it is also useful to note that 2021 sales tax collections from businesses in the District generated \$1.9M (11.8%) more in YTD sales tax collections than in 2019.
- Based on this last comparison, it appears that business in the District is now exceeding pre-pandemic levels of sales.
- Bill Levine with the City calculated sales tax from the District through August 2021 (about \$15.3 million) and divided those by all sales tax collections in the entire City of Aurora through August (about \$162.4 million) and calculated that the District is responsible for generating 9.5% of the City of Aurora’s total sales tax collections so far in 2021.
