BID Budget & Operations:

- BID transitioning accounts from James Moore & Associates to Simmons and Wheeler.
- BID setting up Bill.com with dual signatures for future accounting management.
- BID submitted the 2020 audit by Simmons & Wheeler to the City of Aurora and Spencer Fane.
- [Received \\$145,575.75 from Arapahoe County on 5/10](#) and on 5/14 we have about \$505,328 in the First Bank and \$201,948 in the Bank of the West account.

- [Q1 Sales Tax Report from City of Aurora – Bill Levine](#): See Bill Levine’s notes: The Havana BID was responsible for \$5,189,481 in sales tax collection on a year-to-date basis (Jan 1, 2021 through March 31, 2021). Note: This is the number in Cell N47 of the [report](#)
 - Over the same time period, sales tax collections for the entire city of Aurora have been \$58,550,564.
 - Thus, **about 8.86% of the City’s sales tax revenue was generated by the Havana BID!**
 - **He did the same calculation for the entire 2020 calendar year.** Last year, the Havana BID was responsible for **9.72% of the sale tax generated by the City of Aurora (Havana BID sales tax was \$20,772,823 compared to \$213,780,431).**
 - Bear with this next story (which might seem like a random aside, but it is not). In September, the Aurora City Council implemented a new Marketplace Facilitator Ordinance that required online sales companies to collect sales tax from third parties who use the online company’s platform to sell (think Amazon or eBay as examples of companies that sell the products of third parties, although there are also others).
 - My point of bringing this up is that we have grown our **tax base by extending sales tax to these types of transactions.**
 - He suspects this is at least partly why the Havana BID’s Q1 2021 share of sales tax went down slightly (that is, the decline may not have anything to do with Havana BID sales but may reflect that we are now taxing some online sales that were not previously taxed).
 - **Use Tax Collection: He also calculated that the Havana BID was 1.90% of the City of Aurora’s use tax.** For a wide variety of complex reasons, he does not think this number is that useful or that helpful (or could be easily misinterpreted – is that 1.9% of all use taxes or just certain types?). For example, one of our use taxes (auto use tax) is only generated on autos sold to Aurora residents by out-of-city auto dealers. So, Havana BID will represent 0% of the Auto Use Tax that is collected by the city. He did not include auto use taxes at all in calculating the 1.90%. Regardless, he thinks the simplest, straight-forward thing is to focus **ONLY** about sales tax. Aurora has just over twenty sources of General Fund revenue, but sales tax makes up 54% of the General Fund revenue stream. Sales tax is hugely important, and we all spend a lot of time talking about it (much more than we spent talking about use taxes). For these reasons, he recommended keeping the analysis simple and focusing only on the sales tax piece.

Live On Havana Street Update:

- **Mubarak Villa:** This is a 20-unit duplex development in ten buildings on 1.75 acres proposed on the north side of Jewell Avenue, about a quarter mile west of Havana Street. “Mubarak Villa is finalizing fees with the School District - expect that it will be recorded within a week or two. The civil plan process almost complete.”
- **Argenta:** Phase 1- 3.6 acres for 86 townhomes construction is in progress. Argenta is a phased master plan for 10.55 acres new mixed-use development consisting of 86 townhomes, 208 multi-family & 20,000 SF of small-scale retail. “Argenta received approval for apartments and commercial (Phase 2); working on finishing up technical reviews and resubmittal.”
- **Mountain View United Church & Habitat for Humanity** have “formed a collaborative partnership with the Congregation Land Campaign and Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver. They are creating a site plan using its vacant property next to the church to provide inclusive, owner-occupied, affordable housing for working families in the 60-80% Area Median Income range.” – from a blog post in [MVUC's website](#). There are 6 locations where work will occur:

1. 1st Ave to south (SB Havana St) – Asphalt overlay operation over original trench patch. (12' width)
2. SB Havana St at Hanover – Removing the temporary asphalt patch and replace with permanent.
3. SB Havana St just south of 6th Ave (includes some of the NB left turn lane as well.) – Asphalt overlay operation over original trench patch (12' width)
4. EB 6th Ave (in the intersection) – Replace temporary patching and replace with permanent. (Unsure at this time when Public Works will allow this work, whether daytime, nighttime, or weekend.)
5. SB Havana St (7th Ave to 6th Ave) – Replace temp patching with permanent.
6. There is also some concrete curb work to be finished south of 1st Ave (west side); sidewalk repair at 590 Havana (east side) and another sidewalk repair just south of 7th Ave (west side).

Havana Motor Mile:

Business Watch Updates: See below for crime states from [Lexis Nexis Community Crime Map](#) for the Havana District. Due to Covid-19, Chance does periodic “biz watch drives” of the district, reporting and addressing graffiti, signage, illegally parked vehicles, trash dumped, damaged traffic signage and visible poverty/travelers/homeless issues as part of our Havana District “Clean and Safe” efforts. The BID shared the City of Aurora's newsletter blog, “[Keeping you and your neighborhood safe: tips from Aurora Police.](#)”

APD Sergeant Graham also shared other useful resources for BID businesses regarding safety and crime prevention for the BID:

1. **Signage on Properties for Auto Theft Prevention:** The [Park Smart Program Businesses](#) can [purchase these signs](#) and hang them in their parking lots or on their buildings to remind patrons to not leave anything of value in their vehicle to help prevent themselves from becoming victims. APD provided quotes for signs [here](#).

2. **Lighting Drive:** APD was out working an operation and during the downtime, “APD took a run up and down Havana St. to see what it looks like at night. Some businesses like the O'Reilly had minimal business lights and no parking lot lights. The Hungry Wolf had no lights at all. Schomp Ford, the whole southwest lot was dark while the rest of the lots were lit. Several other lots had poor lighting or burn out lights. Parking lot north of Discount Tire has no parking lot lights on. This is one of the troubled areas with the Hookah Bar. Many of the businesses like the major car lots and the large shopping centers had good lighting.” [Chance reached out to the businesses and shared Partners in Energy resources with the BID.](#)
3. **LiveView Technologies:** APD looked into the surveillance in KingSoopers’ parking lots that other BID members mentioned at previous BID meetings. The equipment belongs to a company out of Utah call LiveView Tech. They can lease you their system and then you can set it up and monitor it from the cloud. The system is portable, so you can easily move it from place to place. You can zoom, pan, and capture pictures or video. Some models have speakers where you can record messages or speak over it. As far as APD knows, we do not have any other interaction with the company yet.
