Aurora Economic Resiliency (AER) Grant Program Open only from Nov. 5-12

Are you an Aurora business or nonprofit struggling with payroll or rent hardships?

You might qualify for a grant up to \$30,000 from the Aurora Economic Resiliency Grant Program, funded by at least \$5 million from the Arapahoe and Adams county CARES programs.

Businesses/nonprofits that previously qualified for AER funds are eligible for this funding to help with rent and payroll, as our new applicants.

ELIGIBLE BUSINESSES MUST:

- Be under 200 employees
- Have an Aurora business license in good standing

ELIGIBLE NONPROFITS MUST:

- Have either an Aurora business license
OR
- Be registered with the state of Colorado and either have an Aurora location or be able to demonstrate that over 50% of the clients served are Aurora residents

New applicants: Application will be posted Thursday, Nov. 5, at AuroraGov.org/AER.

Prior AER1 and AER2 qualified applicants: Look for an email that will be sent to you Nov. 5 with a link to a short interest form for you to complete to be considered for funding.

Applications or interest forms are due by 11:59 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 12.
