

February 2022 – What’s Happening On Havana Street & BID Updates:

BID Budget & Operations:

- Received \$4,849.14 from Arapahoe County on 2/9 from January 2022’s Distribution Report and on 2/11/2022 we had about \$418,583.94 in the First Bank and as of 02/01/22 we had \$201,929.39 in the PLUS+ ColoTrust Savings Account.
- **City of Aurora Incremental Payment to the Havana BID** - BID will be receiving \$90,779.70 for payments received in 2020 for the GOH TIF. Chance will notify the board when the payment is received and deposited.
- 3 NEW BID BOD members were confirmed on 12/20/2021: Kerstin Hitchcock with Gary’s Full-Service Auto Repair LLC, Jennifer Dunn with First Bank and Alex Lee with New Gate Construction. We are working on submitting all the documents for the new board appointments to Spencer Fane.
- **Colorado Special District Pool:** The District has Safety and Loss Prevention Grant funds that are due to expire. Allocations which remain unused after five years are lost, so it is important to make regular use of this program to reap its full benefit. On March 31, 2022, \$326.25 will expire from your current allocation. Today, the HBID has a current balance of \$1,250.53.

Live On Havana Street Update:

- **A new application for duplexes was received by a Rachid in the Planning at 2225 S Iola St. behind Addis Ababa Ethiopian Restaurant.**
- **Mountain View United Church & Habitat for Humanity** have “formed a collaborative partnership with the Congregation Land Campaign and Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver. They are creating a site plan using its vacant property next to the church to provide inclusive, owner-occupied, affordable housing for working families in the 60-80% Area Median Income range.” – from a blog post in [MVUC's website](#). - **Mubarak Villa:** This is a 20-unit duplex development in ten buildings on 1.75 acres proposed on the north side of Jewell Avenue, about a quarter mile west of Havana Street. **“Mubarak Villa is finalizing fees with the School District and the civil plan process almost complete.”**

Notes from Planners in late 2021 for Argenta (No new updates since 12/2021):

- **Argenta: Tom Klein with Dillon Place sold his shares to Dream Finder Homes 4 months ago.**
- **Dream Finder will continue the Argenta development moving forward. Learn More Here:** <https://www.dreamfindershomes.com/focus-on-dream-finders-homes/>
- **Phase 1-** 3.6 acres for 86 townhomes construction is in progress. Argenta is a phased master plan for 10.55 acres new mixed-use development consisting of 86 townhomes, 208 multi-family & 20,000 SF of small-scale retail.
- **Townhomes (Phase 1): Summary timeframe:** The contractor must complete, water, related road work on Geneva, and other work for the city. There has been no construction on buildings to date and is not likely until Spring 2022.
- **Multi-Family Units (Phase II): Summary timeframe:** Before MF units can start construction, the N-S Road would have to be completed. To complete road, they would likely stop in October due to freeze-thaw and would not complete the N-S Road until spring. Sometime after that Phase II could begin.
- **Wet Utilities:** The contractors must complete wet utilities before they can start the N-S road through the center of the development. This road must be installed for Phase 2 (MF / Retail) to start construction. Timeframe: wet utilities - 2-3 weeks.
- **N-S Road Phase 2 (for Multi-Family): Summary timeframe:** before N-S Road can start, it would take at minimum 2 months to complete construction including wet utilities timing above. To complete road, they would likely stop in October due to freeze-thaw and could not complete the N-S Road until spring. (Notes from Chad Argentar & Philip Nachbar, Development Project Manager, Planning & Development Services Department)

District Identity: The BID supports our stakeholders in new OHS district markers, signage, and public art engagement with the ART2C program with the City of Aurora's AAIPP.

- **District Markers with On Havana Street panels:** First Bank's monument was damaged in a traffic fatality and their new sign is up, but our panels still need to be replaced.
- Dozens' new ownership is also interested in a district marker sign when they do the exterior, landscaping, and sign improvements for their property. Chance helped connect them with City planning and code enforcement.
- Carpet Exchange, Jordan Motors, and Western Centers at Havana Exchange Shopping Center are all interested in new panels or in the district marker program. We are waiting on proposals from the stakeholders to present to the board for a vote.
- Kum & Go at Havana & Jewel expressed interest in adding an On Havana Street sign to their monument if BID can provide the panels then KG will cover the install in early 2023. Also, Kum & Go offered to add an 8x8 concrete pad for the ART 2C public art program if the District supports the additional sculpture to the Art 2C program. This pad would not be available until 2023 so it would be included in the 2024-2026 program.
- **AAIPP Art2C:** Tony is no longer with City and a new art coordinator was hired in the beginning of February and we hope to schedule a planning meeting soon regarding our Call for Art for Art2C 2022-2024.
- **Lightshade Art Mural with OHS branding:** Doug Scott is no longer with Lightshade. A deposit to the muralist was sent and the mural project will begin mid-February 2022.

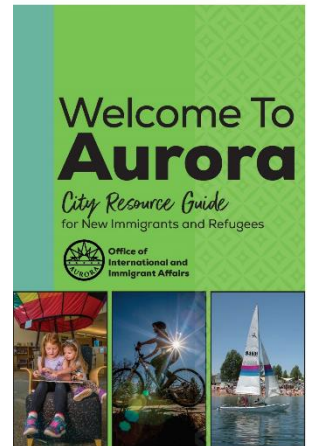

- This number is intended for *public safety issues (police, medical, fire)* which are *neither in progress nor emergent*.
- These calls hold *lesser priority* to 9-1-1 calls. It is common to be placed on hold by a call-taker so they may answer 9-1-1 calls.
- The line is answered by a voice tree which provides dial options to directly connect you with commonly requested public safety resources, such as the tow impound lot, retrieving your property from the APD, and requesting a police report, and Access Aurora for other city resources
- This line is not an emergency line, nor a city switchboard. Hold time is common and should be expected,
- If you hang up from calling this line, we will not return your call.
